Order:-

The Government in Government Order first read above have issued orders for constitution of 32 District Child Protection Societies in the then 32 districts.

2. Since there is a need to appoint a District Child Protection Officer immediately on time scale of pay to cull out the difficulties in the present arrangement and more importantly to have accountability and time bound

commitments, the Government in Government order second read above have accorded sanction for creation of 32 posts of District Child Protection Officers in the time scale of pay of Rs.15600-39100 + GP '5400' temporarily for a period of one year from the date of filling up of the post. Further, the post continuance for the above posts have been obtained upto the period of 29.02.2024 in the Government order seventh read above.

- 3. The Government in Government Orders third read above have issued orders for creation of new districts namely Kallakurichi, Tenkasi, Chengalpattu, Tirupathur and Ranipet. Subsequently, the Government in Government Order fourth read above have also issued orders for creation of new district namely Mayiladuthurai.
- 4. The Government of India in its letter fifth read above, among others has released Grants-in-aid of Rs.1084.39 lakh towards Central Share for the component District Child Protection Unit [(recurring grants for 32 existing DCPUs) and (entire non-recurring grant for 6 new DCPUs and recurring grants for 6 new DCPUs for 2 months of Financial Year 2020-2021 w.e.f. Feb, 2021)] under the scheme of "Child Protection Services" (CPS) for the year 2020-2021. The Government of India in its letter sixth read above among others has also released Grants-in-aid of Rs.211.09 lakh towards Central share as first instalment for 38 DCPUs under the scheme namely "Mission Vatsalya" (Child Protection Services and Child Welfare Services) for the current financial year 2021-2022.
- 5. The Director of Social Defence in the letter eighth read above has sent a proposal to Government for formation of 6 District Child Protection Units in the newly created districts of Kallakurichi, Tenkasi, Chengalpattu, Tirupathur, Ranipet and Mayiladuthurai as per section 106 of the Juvenile Justice Act, 2015 and also to create the post of District Child Protection Officer in the time scale of pay (Pay level 22 Rs.56,100 2,05,700) and other staff on consolidated pay as per the norms of the Child Protection Services Scheme in 6 Districts at a total cost of Rs.4,00,35,864/- (Non-Recurring Expenditure Rs.31,50,000/- and Recurring Expenditure Rs.3,68,85,864/-) @ Rs.66,72,644/- per district under Child Protection Services Scheme.
- 6. Meanwhile, the Hon'ble Minister for Social Welfare and Women Empowerment Department on 01.09.2021 while moving the demand No.45 of Social Welfare and Women Empowerment Department in the Tamil Nadu Legislative Assembly has made the following as a part of one of the announcements for the year 2021-2022:-

"New District Child Protection Units will be established by the Government of Tamil Nadu in the new 6 districts namely Tenkasi, Kallakurichi, Mayiladuthurai, Tirupathur, Ranipet and Chengalpattu".

- 7. After careful examination, the Government accept the proposal of the Director of Social Defence and issue orders as follows:-
 - (i) Sanction is accorded for formation of 6 District Child Protection Units in the newly created Districts of Kallakurichi, Tenkasi,

Chengalpattu, Tirupathur, Ranipet and Mayiladuthurai as per section 106 of the Juvenile Justice (Care and Protection of Children) Act, 2015 at a total cost of Rs.4,00,35,864/-(Rupees four crore, thirty five thousand, eight hundred and sixty four only) [Recurring Expenditure Rs.3,68,85,864/- (Central share 60% Rs.2,21,31,518/- + State share 40% Rs.1,47,54,346/-) and Non-Recurring Expenditure Rs.31,50,000/- (Central Share 60% Rs.18,90,000/- + State Share 40% Rs.12,60,000/-)] @ Rs.66,72,644/- per District Child Protection Unit;

(ii) Financial sanction is accorded for a sum of Rs.1,54,45,288/-(Rupees one crore, fifty four lakh, forty five thousand, two hundred and eighty eight only) [Recurring Expenditure for 4 months Rs.1,22,95,288/- (Central share 60% Rs.73,77,173/- + State share 40% Rs.49,18,115/-) and Non-Recurring Expenditure in full Rs.31,50,000/- (Central Share 60% Rs.18,90,000/- + State Share 40% Rs.12,60,000/-)] for 6 District Child Protection Units for the year 2021-2022 under the Child Protection Services Scheme

and

- (iii) Sanction is also accorded for creation of 6 posts of District Child Protection Officer in time scale of pay i.e. in pay level 22, (Rs.56,100 2,05,700) temporarily for a period of three years from the date of filling up of the post and other posts on consolidated pay as per Child Protection Services Scheme norms as detailed in the annexure to this order.
- 8. Out of the expenditure sanctioned in para 7(ii) above, a sum of Rs.1,37,86,000/- shall be debited under the following heads of account:-
